

Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC) after the preliminary analysis of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) from the PvPI database reveals that the following suspected drug is associated with the ADR as given below.

S.No	SUSPECTED DRUG	INDICATIONS	ADVERSE DRUG REACTION
1	Tranexamic Acid	• For the treatment of abnormal bleeding in which local hyperfibrinolysis is considered to be involved (pulmonary, haemorrhage, epistaxis, renal bleeding abnormal bleeding during or after prostate surgery). • Haemorrhage or risk of haemorrhage in increased fibrinolysis of hereditary angioneurotic oedema. • For the treatment of excessive bleeding in patients with hemophilia during & following tooth extraction. • For the treatment of menorrhagia. • For the prevention of oral hemorrhage in anticoagulant treated patients undergoing oral surgery.	Nasal Congestion
2	Metoclopramide	• To restore normal coordination and tone the upper digestive tract and relieve symptoms of gastro-duodenal dysfunction including heartburn, dyspepsia, nausea and vomiting associated with such conditions as reflux oesophagitis, gastritis, duodenitis and hiatus hernia. • For the treatment of nausea and vomiting.	Tachycardia
