Indian Pharmacopoeia Commission (IPC) after the preliminary analysis of Adverse Drug Reactions (ADRs) from the PvPI database reveals that the following suspected drug is associated with the ADR as given below.

S.NO	SUSPECTED DRUG	INDICATIONS	ADVERSE DRUG REACTION
1	Vancomycin	Treatment of serious infection due to Gram-positive cocci including methicillin-resistant staphylococcal infections, brain abscess, staphylococcal meningitis and septicaemia.	Drug Reaction with Eosinophilia and Systemic Symptoms (DRESS) Syndrome.

Healthcare Professionals, Patients/Consumers are advised to closely monitor the possibility of the above ADR associated with the use of above suspected drug.
